Brown Campaign Releases "American Jobs Plan" and New TV Commercial on the Economy - "Table Talk."

Releasing Economic Plan and Ad featuring Placer County Republicans Craig and Dian Raether, Brown Renews Call for Bi-Partisan Congressional Action on Economic Crisis

Roseville: This week, the Charlie Brown for Congress campaign released a new 60-second TV commercial entitled "Table Talk," which also highlights Lt. Col. Brown's blueprint for getting our economy going and creating new, high paying American jobs.

The spot is running throughout CA-04 on broadcast and cable TV, and features Placer County Republicans Craig and Dian Raether discussing their family's financial situation during these tough economic times and why they are supporting retired Lt. Col. Charlie Brown for Congress.

"Families are struggling to keep their jobs, meet the mortgage, fill their gas tanks, pay for healthcare, educate their children, and save for retirement," said retired Lt. Col. Charlie Brown.

"Partisan bickering is not going to solve any of these problems," Brown continued. "We need real plans and the commitment to work together to solve problems. Our campaign is about taking action, that's why we have put out a comprehensive energy plan, a jobs plan and have donated over \$50,000 to local veterans organizations."

Following two weeks that saw the largest bank failure and largest single day Dow Jones Average point drop in American history, Brown also renewed his call for Congressional action on the bi-partisan economic recovery plan that passed yesterday in the U.S. Senate.

"With small businesses unable to access the credit they need to run their businesses and create jobs, retirees losing the savings they worked so hard to accumulate, and foreclosures reaching record levels, inaction by Congress is not an option," Brown said. "While far from perfect, the new plan addresses the immediate needs of families, taxpayers and small businesses caught in the cross hairs of this crisis, prevents golden parachutes for the irresponsible executives who created this mess, and takes important steps to restore oversight so this will not happen again."

Brown noted that the Senate bill also includes Secure Rural Schools and Roads funding through 2011—which provides up to a third of the budgets for several of District 4’s county governments.

Transcript of "Table Talk" 60-second television commercial:

Dian: The whole reason we planned our lives to move up here and live in this area and buy our house here, and, you know, make our life the way we did was so that I could be home with my children.

Craig: I was laid off from my job. I worked at Oracle for eight years, and my job was cut in favor of moving it to India.

Dian: Losing your job can make you lose your house. And that's the reason that I had to go back to work.

Craig: What is the best solution? What fixes things for people? I am very impressed with Charlie.

Dian: Me too.

Craig: I think he's a straight shooter. I think he understands the problems of government. That he understands the problems of people.

Dian: Take our interests and present them. You know, speak, for us.

Craig: Charlie Brown has my support – a hundred percent.

Charlie Brown: I am Charlie Brown and I approved this message.

Retired Lt. Col. Charlie Brown spent 26 years in the U.S. Air Force, flying rescue helicopters at the end of the Vietnam War, piloting reconnaissance missions around the world, and coordinating a variety of intelligence collection assets. His decorations include the Distinguished Flying Cross, Sikorsky Winged S, 7 Air Medals, and 5 Meritorious Service Medals. A graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy, Brown also owns a California teaching credential and served 8 years on the Professional Staff of the Roseville Police Department.
