BROWN TO ATTEND 4th OF JULY EVENTS IN LINCOLN, ROSEVILLE, GRASS VALLEY, AUBURN, AND ALTURAS

Noting McClintock's lack of Public Schedule, Brown Campaign Asks, "Where's Tom?"

Charlie Brown for Congress today announced its 4th of July weekend public schedule, during which Retired USAF Lt. Col. Charlie Brown will be participating in community celebrations in King's Beach, Lincoln, Roseville, Grass Valley, Auburn, and Alturas.

"The 4th of July is a time to celebrate freedom, and all that our great country and our community has to offer," Brown said. "I am looking forward to meeting with friends, family, and neighbors from across the region where I have been proud to live, work and raise my family these past 17 years."

In addition to releasing Brown's own public schedule---which is continuously updated and available at Brown's website, www.charliebrownforcongress.org, Brown Campaign Manager Todd Stenhouse noted that Tom McClintock has been noticeably silent in recent weeks, and notably absent from community events, including last weekend's Rocklin Jubilee and Cameron Park Summer Spectacular.

"Southern California politician Tom McClintock is showing himself to be just like John Doolittle ---he has no public schedule on his website, almost never attends community events, and renders himself accessible to special interests in Washington, but inaccessible to the public at large," Stenhouse said. "Charlie Brown knows that representing a community means being a part of that community, understanding its strengths and opportunities, regularly meeting with constituents, and bringing people of all political stripes together to solve problems. As the people of Southern California already know, when it comes to the issue of local leadership, Tom McClintock has been AWOL his entire career."

Charlie Brown spent 26 years in the U.S. Air Force, flying rescue helicopters at the end of the Vietnam War, piloting reconnaissance missions around the world, and coordinating a variety of intelligence collection assets. His decorations include the Distinguished Flying Cross, Sikorsky Winged S, 7 Air Medals, and 5 Meritorious Service Medals. Charlie's wife Jan is also a veteran, and his son has served four rotations in Iraq with the Air Force. A graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy, Brown also owns a Masters in Aviation Management from Embry Riddle University, and a California teaching credential. He served 8 years on the Professional Staff of the Roseville Police Department, and is a candidate for Congress in California's 4th District.
